

UNIFORM LIST

The official stockists for all items of the school's uniform, with the exception of the PE kit, are Peter Jones of Sloane Square, SW1 and Sogan's, 6 Greyhound Road, W6. School uniform sweatshirts and PE sweatshirts can only be ordered through the school. Shirts, skirts, blazers and 'V' necked jumpers can only be obtained from Peter Jones or Sogan's and no alternatives are permitted. The Headteacher is always willing to help parents in case of financial difficulty and uniform grants are available in some cases from the Local Authority. An annual sale of second-hand uniform is held for the benefit of parents whose daughters are joining Year 7 and parents will be notified of this date in advance. Girls must have the following items of uniform: striped shirt, skirt, jumper or sweatshirt, blazer, tights or socks, shoes and PE uniform.

UNIFORM

- ⇒ **Shirt** – Red pin-striped short or long-sleeved shirt in cotton or cotton mix.
- ⇒ **Skirt** - A straight skirt, a box pleated style and an A-line style are available from Sogan's. An inverted pleat style skirt is available from Peter Jones. Parents are asked to ensure that their daughter's skirt is an appropriate length for school wear (on or just above the knee).



- ⇒ **Blazers** - Black with red pin-stripe. Blazers must be worn to or from school every day (except in exceptionally hot weather when they should be carried). During very cold or wet weather a black, navy or dark grey overcoat or raincoat should be worn over the blazer. Each girl must wear a blazer for church services and special occasions.

EITHER

⇒ **School 'V' necked jumper** - available from Sogan's or Peter Jones.

OR

⇒ **Sweatshirt** - There is a school sweatshirt with the Lady Margaret Tudor Rose logo available only from the school office.

⇒ **Shoes** - Girls must wear a business-like style such as a lace-up or pull-on that is not too low cut. All shoes should have low heels and give firm support to the feet. Shoes must be plain black leather. Black or brown leather boots may be worn if the weather is bad, but only to and from school.

⇒ **Tights** – Plain (no patterns) or ribbed in black.

OR

⇒ **Socks** - Plain white or black.

⇒ **Coats** must be full length, plain black, navy or dark grey wool or gabardine. Only duffles, plain coats (i.e. no gilt or silver buttons, no fur collars) or raincoats are allowed. In wet weather girls are permitted to wear red or black cagoules.

⇒ **Gloves** (optional) - Plain red or black.

⇒ **Scarf** (optional) - Plain black.

⇒ **Hat** (optional) – Plain black, woolly.

⇒ **Headbands** (optional) - plain red, black or white.

⇒ **Pursebelt** (optional) - black or red.

⇒ One pair of discreet plain gold or silver stud earrings in the lower ear and small crosses are the only jewellery permitted (value should be less than £15).

SUMMER UNIFORM

Girls wear their winter skirts with red and white striped shirts.

⇒ **Tights and Socks** - As for Winter.

⇒ **Blazers** - Black with red pin-stripe. Blazers must be worn or carried on the journey to and from school.

P.E. UNIFORM

Items marked with an asterisk can only be ordered through the school. Most of the following items can be bought at the school outfitters, Peter Jones and Sogan's, and at other retail outlets.

- ⇒ **Trainers** - Predominantly white or black.
- ⇒ * **Sweatshirt** – with LMS logo and embroidered with pupil's name
- ⇒ **Games socks** - scarlet. (Your daughter should have a change of socks for all games lessons).
- ⇒ **Tracksuit bottoms** – PLAIN black (no stripes or logos)
- ⇒ **Shirt** - White aertex (with collar)
- ⇒ **Leotard** - Plain black.
- ⇒ **EITHER - Cycling Shorts** – PLAIN black – no stripes or logos
- ⇒ **OR – Football Shorts** – PLAIN black – no stripes or logos
- ⇒ * **Cash's Name Tapes**

MARKING OF UNIFORM

We are well aware that school uniform costs money and it is our endeavour to make sure that girls do not lose track of their property in school. The careful and clear marking of your daughter's property helps you and us to achieve this aim, and in order to discourage borrowing which leads to confusion, losses and annoyance to staff and parents, you are asked to make sure that all clothing and property is marked clearly with the owner's name. For PE, items should be marked as follows:

Leotard - left front shoulder.

White aertex shirt - left front shoulder.

Football or cycle Shorts - bottom left corner.

Tracksuit bottoms - top left leg.

Trainers - the owner's name in full should be written inside and initials anywhere on the outside.

The PE sweatshirt will be embroidered with the owner's name. All other articles must be clearly marked with the owner's name on name tapes which are available from the school.

NOTE: We are very proud of the school's uniform and expect the highest standards from the girls and we expect that all parents, having chosen a school which has uniform, will support us at all times in this matter. The girls are required to wear regulation uniform when in school and on the journey to and from school. If for any reason your daughter is unable to wear any item of her school uniform, she must bring a note to her form tutor to explain the reason and if there is a suitable article in the second-hand uniform cupboard, we will loan her an article for a day or two.

EQUIPMENT

Girls are expected to provide the following for classroom use:

- ⇒ For all subjects: pens, pencils, rubber, ruler, (with metric and imperial measure), scissors, rough book, Collins English Dictionary* (which can be purchased from the school at a cost of £9), pencil sharpener.
- ⇒ For French: Collins French Dictionary* – Bilingual, which can be purchased from the school at a cost of £8.
- ⇒ For Spanish: Collins Spanish Dictionary* - Bilingual, which can be purchased from the school at a cost of £8.
- ⇒ For Art: B and 2B pencils, pencil sharpener, rubber, felt-tip pens, compass, scissors, ruler and Pritt Stick.
- ⇒ For Mathematics: compass, ruler, scissors, Pritt Stick and angle measurer. Girls will also need a calculator. The Mathematics Department recommends a basic Casio model (model number beginning with FX-9) costing approximately £6-7.
- ⇒ For Technology: compass, ruler, set square, HB pencils, colouring pencils scissors, pencil sharpener and a plastic rubber (a Staedtler is recommended), a band or hairclips to tie hair back.
- ⇒ For Religious Studies: *Sunrise Good News Bible*, which can be purchased from the school at a cost of £12.50.

*** Parents can purchase the dictionaries from a book store themselves or they can be pre-ordered and paid for on Induction Morning and will be delivered to school by the start of term in September.**
